Memorial day in honor of Founding of the Republic of China	January 1	Wednesday	One day off in accordance with the established rules.
Lunar New Year's Eve	January 23 January 24	Thursday Friday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. January 23 (Thursday) adjusts to holiday; February 15 (Saturday) adjusts to work.
Spring Festival	January 25 January 26 January 27 January 28 January 29	Saturday Sunday Monday Tuesday Wednesday	Three days off from January 25 to 27 in accordance with established rules. As two days of Spring Festival fall on Saturday and Sunday, January 28 (Tuesday) and January 29 (Wednesday) should be the day off to make it up.
Peace Memorial Day	February 28	Friday	One day off in accordance with the established rules.
Children's Day Tomb-sweeping Day	April 2 April 3 April 4	Thursday Friday Saturday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. As Children's Day and Tomb-sweeping Day fall on the same day and also on Saturday, April 3 (Friday) should be the day off, and April 2 (Thursday) should be the day off to make it up.

Labor Day	May 1	Friday	One day off in accordance with the established rules.
Dragon Boat Festival	June 25 June 26	Thursday Friday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. June 26 (Friday) adjusts to holiday; June 20 (Saturday) adjusts to work.
Mid-autumn Festival	October 1 October 2	Thursday Friday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. October 2 (Friday) adjusts to holiday; September 26 (Saturday) adjusts to work.
National (Double Tenth) Day	October 9 October 10	Friday Saturday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. As it falls on Saturday, October 9 (Friday) should be the day off to make it up.
